Emergency First Aid at Work



Employers are responsible for the provision of appropriate first aid equipment and facilities and trained first aiders in respect of their employees. However, the Regulations do not oblige employers to provide first aid for anyone else. Nevertheless, HSE strongly encourages employers to consider others when carrying out their assessment of first aid needs and to make provision for them.

Course Outline



A minimum six-hour programme for individuals who wish to gain knowledge of emergency procedures and attain a recognised HSE approved qualification in First Aid.

HSE strongly advise that annual refresher training (minimum of 3 hours) should be conducted for all trained personal, HACS can provide refresher training .

For 'low risk' working environment and or limited employees you should consider to appoint and train an Emergency First Aider at Work (EFAW). For further details on first aid considerations see 'First aid at Work'.
