Paediatric First Aid for schools



It is a legal requirement for employers to provide adequate personnel, training, equipment and facilities to render First Aid to their employees should they become injured or taken ill at work.

This two-day course in Emergency First Aid has been developed for those who are responsible for the supervision of children and babies. This will be of particular interest to Child Minders and Crèche Assistants, Playgroup personnel and anyone responsible for youth organisations. This course is recognised by **OFSTED**.



Course Outline

The aim of this course is to provide these persons with a sound knowledge and understanding of First Aid procedures when working with children and babies, along with the ability to recognise and treat many childhood conditions and illnesses.

Although the majority of First Aid procedures are similar to those used in adult First Aid there are substantial differences in the protocols for resuscitation, choking, casualty handling and incident management.
