DEFIBRILLATOR



Automated External Defibrillators (AED's) should be provided at public events or in public areas including corporate and government offices, shopping centres, airports, restaurants, casinos, hotels, sports stadiums, schools and universities, community centres, fitness centres, health clubs, workplaces and any other location where people may congregate.

Cardiac Arrest is the biggest killer in the UK. Over 150,000 die as a result. The majority could have been saved if a defibrillator was made available.



Locating AED's

The location of a AED should be taken in to account where large groups of people gather, regardless of age or activity. Children as well as adults may fall victim to sudden cardiac arrest.

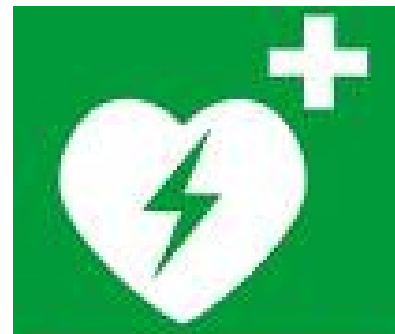
This very practical course will allow **suitably qualified First Aid personnel** and Lifeguards to use the AED competently and with confidence.

Although at present there is no legislation governing Defibrillators, training is essential. HACS Training follow the guidelines and beyond of the European Resuscitation Council and the Resuscitation Council UK to ensure a comprehensive programme.

Course Content :

Not only does this course deal with the use of an AED but also revisits some basic First Aid skills, including resuscitation

- Recap – primary and Secondary assessments
- Heart Attack and Cardiac Arrest
- Chain of survival
- Defibrillation
- Control of vomiting



The HSE strongly recommend refresher training for all first aiders. This should include AED qualified first aiders
